Voluntary National Insurance contributions and the State Pension

If you have gaps in your National Insurance (NI) record, and you're not on track to get the full State Pension, April 5 is an important deadline. The rules say you may be entitled to plug any gaps in your NI record by making voluntary National Insurance contributions.



Normally you can only go back six years, but until April 5 this year, you can go back as far as 2006. Find out more on the [Gov.uk website](#) and you can read more about the State Pension in our State Pension guide.

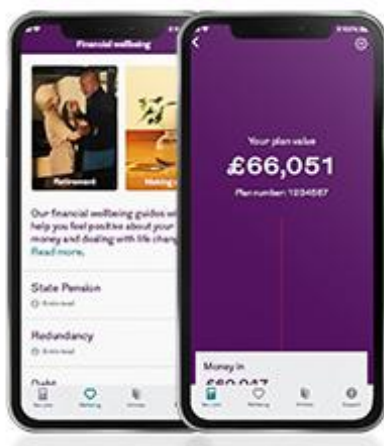
